Phuentsholing–Jaigaon border point is the [main gateway](#) and witnesses the most amount of traffic resulting from both tourism and trade. This is also the main point that offers Bhutan access to the sea via the Kolkata and Haldia ports. This route was recognised by the Government of India and the Royal Government of Bhutan in the [2016](#) Agreement on Trade and Transit.
